Itinerary

Day 1: Day 1: Drive from Kathmandu to Chitwan

Altitude: 415 m / 1,362 ft

Drive Duration: 5–6 Hours

Accommodation: Jungle Resort

Meals: Lunch & Dinner

Depart Kathmandu after breakfast and travel through scenic river valleys and rolling hills to Chitwan National Park. Upon arrival, check into your jungle resort and enjoy a welcome drink. In the evening, take a short walk around the nearby Tharu village and experience a colorful Tharu cultural dance performance that showcases the traditions of the local community.

Day 2: Day 2: Full-Day Jungle Safari Experience

Altitude: 415 m / 1,362 ft

Activity Duration: Full Day

Accommodation: Jungle Resort

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Spend the day exploring the diverse ecosystems of Chitwan National Park. Begin with a peaceful canoe ride along the Rapti River, where you may spot gharial crocodiles and a variety of birdlife. Continue with a guided jungle walk before embarking on an exciting jeep safari through grasslands and forests in search of the endangered one-horned rhinoceros, Bengal tiger, wild elephants, deer, sloth bears, and numerous bird species.

Day 3: Day 3: Bird Watching & Leisure Activities

Altitude: 415 m / 1,362 ft

Activity Duration: 5–6 Hours

Accommodation: Jungle Resort

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Start the morning with a guided bird-watching excursion, as Chitwan National Park is home to more than 500 species of birds. The remainder of the day can be spent enjoying optional resort activities, visiting the Elephant Breeding Center (if operating), relaxing by the riverside, or exploring the surrounding natural landscapes at your own pace.

Day 4: Day 4: Drive from Chitwan to Kathmandu

Drive Duration: 5–6 Hours

Meals: Breakfast

After breakfast, bid farewell to Chitwan and begin the scenic drive back to Kathmandu. Upon arrival, you will be transferred to your hotel or Tribhuvan International Airport, depending on your travel schedule. Depart with unforgettable memories of Nepal's incredible wildlife, lush jungles, and rich Tharu culture.
